Does it seem like any of the text or images were copy-pasted from other source, but it is not clearly labeled as coming from another author? Is there any terms of use or copyright information provided for third-party content?

6. Level of Editing Needed: Based on the technical, privacy, and copyright issues, estimate how the amount of work necessary to make the necessary editing and formatting changes to share the materials as OER.

7. Level of Publishing Needed: Indicate if the course needs any specialized layout in the OER publishing platform. Where do you need clarity from the author(s) on how to structure the materials on the website?

8. Next Steps: Is there an appointed individual who has the skills or can be trained to complete the editing and publishing? Are there additional file(s) that need to be collected? What is the cost, work estimate, and proposed timeline for sharing the files as open educational resources?
