I put the dogs because he is wanting to see his dogs but I got to see the therapy dog on the 7th floor and that made me feel a little better.

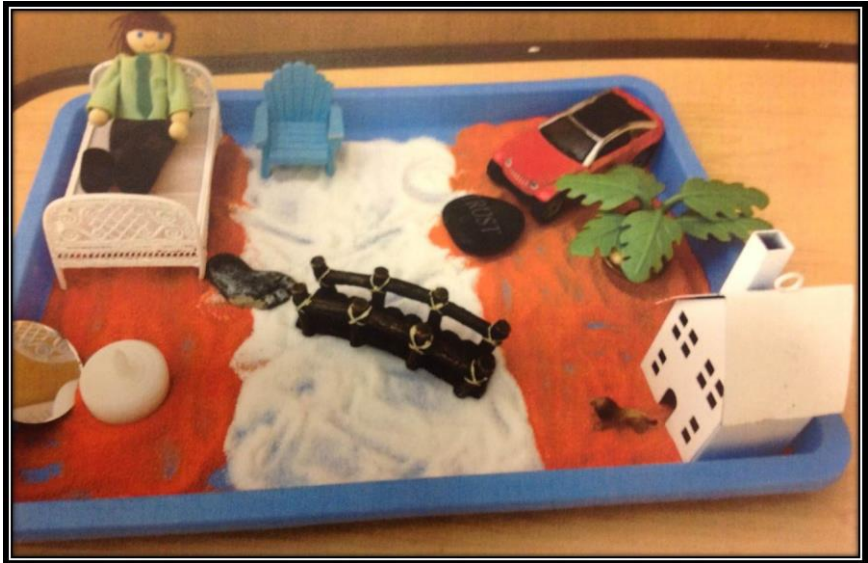
Then he is thinking about his make-a-wish trip to Florida. He got better and got to go. That is what the plant stands for.
