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Resource Title: Session 4.1: Developing Your District Disaster Management Plan

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Introduction: The key output of this training is that individual districts have to develop their disaster plans. In the next sessions, you will work in your groups to develop these plans

General Objective

Development of a district disaster plan based on the rationale that disaster situations are largely similar and preparedness for a large-scale disaster implies preparedness for all other disasters

Specific Objectives

At the end of this series of sessions the participant should:

1. Identify activities for the strategic and operational objectives of Disaster Management Matrix
2. Prepare the capability based district disaster plan
